The purpose of the <u>2024 My Brother's Keeper and Girls' Equity Network Michigan statewide Summit</u> is to come together to support Black and Brown youth and to collectively organize around what they need to thrive in education and in their lives holistically.

What does it look like for youth to have opportunities to learn and grow that feed their whole being?

How can we change the narrative that education is only a pathway to labor and productivity (which is then equated to our value as people)?

How do we collectively foster youth entrepreneurship that uplifts young people's passions while contributing to the good of the world?

How do we address the significant gaps experienced by Black and Brown youth in education and prosperity?

### Because there continue to be very real gaps.

In Michigan, <u>nearly 30% of third-graders aren't reading at grade level</u>, with Black and Latinx students at disproportionately lower rates. Factors like underfunded schools, lack of access to quality early childhood education, socioeconomic challenges, and racial biases in educational practices all contribute to these gaps. We are working to illuminate these patterns with data via the <u>Lansing Racial Equity Scorecard</u>.

Students who do not achieve literacy by the end of third grade are at a significant disadvantage in all subsequent learning. They struggle to keep up with more complex subjects, leading to a higher likelihood of academic failure, disengagement from school, and even dropping out.

Meanwhile, as we see a <u>decline in Black and Latinx student enrollment at notable US</u> <u>colleges</u> following the supreme court's decision on affirmative action, it's crucial to recognize what this means for the next generation of young leaders – a generation that could miss so many.

It's vital to tackle these disparities and ensure every child has the foundation they need to succeed. By doing so, we can help create a more inclusive and equitable future for




